Co-requirements:

- 1 unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (partial scholarships available) done in conjunction with the regular schedule of the chaplaincy classes as an extended unit. (Certification options will be “Certification in Public Safety Chaplaincy” or “Certification in Public Safety Chaplaincy with Clinical Pastoral Education.”) Possible times for extended unit would be September through December 2019 or January through May 2020)
- Post Critical Incident Seminar (PCIS): Students will be required to attend one PCIS event as an observer. The schedule for these events may be found on the SCLEAP website www.scleap.org. The PCIS is a 3-day seminar and is offered by SCLEAP four times per year.
